Such change order will decrease the value of the contract by \$22,360.00 to a total contract price of \$177,040.00.
 - #P25-005 Olney Road Storm Sewer Reconstruction (Grimmer Construction, Inc.) – Change Order No. 2 to adjust the contract price to reflect the final measured quantities of the various items of work involved, including changes necessary to resolve a conflict discovered during the performance of the work between the storm sewer improvements and an existing sanitary sewer; modifications to manhole structures to connect to existing pipe; and , additional tree removal that included clearing and grubbing the easement, necessary to complete the work. Such change order will increase the value of the contract by \$26,599.01 to a total contract price of \$384,334.01.
